

Pesticide & Asbestos Notification

PESTICIDE NOTIFICATION

New York State Education Law Section 409-H, requires all public and nonpublic elementary and secondary schools to provide written notification to all persons in parental relation, faculty, and staff regarding the potential use of pesticides periodically throughout the school year. The Brentwood Union Free School District is also required to maintain a list of persons in parental relation, faculty, and staff who wish to receive 48-hour prior written notification of certain pesticide applications. If you would like to receive 48-hour prior notification of pesticide applications that are scheduled to occur in your school, please contact the **Plant Facilities Manager**, Buildings and Grounds Office, 99 Oriole Place, Brentwood, NY 11717 or call 631-434-2291 and have your name added to the list for the school building you wish to be notified about. The Brentwood Union Free School District has an Integrated Pest Management Program to reduce pesticide use while providing long-term solutions for pest management. Any pesticides used are applied by a certified pesticide applicator using least hazardous methods.

ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION

It is the intention of Brentwood Union Free School District to comply with all federal and state regulations controlling asbestos and to take whatever steps are necessary to ensure students and employees a healthy and safe environment in which to learn and work. Parents, teacher and employees are welcome to review a copy of the asbestos management plan located in the administrative offices in all schools as well as the Felicio Administration Center and the Buildings and Grounds Office during regular business hours. The Superintendent of Buildings and Grounds is our designated asbestos program coordinator, and all inquires regarding the asbestos plan and asbestos-related issues should be directed to 434-2291.
