





REVIEW YOUR CREDITS

- Sit down with your Counselor and go over your credits/courses
- Are you pushing yourself academically? Honors & AP
 Level
- Weighted GPA- Rank
- Unweighted GPA
- How are your grades?
- Your grades impact your college selection / Transcript
- All of your courses count!
