I APPLIED. WHATS NEXT?



FOLLOW UP:

- **Transcript request form. Ask your school counselor to send your official transcript to the college**
- **Submitted your additional essays as required**
- **Asked your references or school counselor to send letters of recommendation**
- **Requested official transcripts you might have from any other college courses you may have taken outside of high school**
- **Requested official test scores required -- SAT, ACT, AP, or TOEFL**

PAYING FOR COLLEGE



Apply for financial aid:

- **Free** Application for Federal Student Aid, **FAFSA**
- NYS State Aid, Tuition Assistance Program, **TAP**



HOW TO APPLY



- **To be considered for student aid, a student must complete all forms required by a college**
 - Free Application for Federal Student Aid(FAFSA)
 - NYS Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) Application
 - Institutional application (e.g., the CSS Profile)
 - Other as required

- The 2019–20 FAFSA form is here! Some states and schools have limited funds, so submit your application today. Also, check out the new **myStudentAid** app for iOS and Android.

FAFSA: Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID)



- Students, and at least one parent, should apply for the FSA ID
- Apply online while filing the FAFSA or ahead of time by going directly to [FSAID.ed.gov](https://fsaid.ed.gov)

FAFSA Question: Student Eligibility



- **What are some of the most important eligibility qualifications for FAFSA?**
 - Students must be U.S. citizens or eligible non-citizens
 - Students must have valid Social Security Numbers
 - Male students must register or be registered with the US Selective Service System

FAFSA Question: Student Dependence



- **Can a student apply for the FAFSA without reporting their parent's information?**
 - In most cases, students under 24 years of age are required to report parent information
 - Students with special circumstances should consult with the financial aid office

- **Pell Grant – Need based (federal)**
- **Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG)**
- **Work-Study**
- **Perkins Loan**
- **Direct Stafford Loan**
- **Direct PLUS Loan**

NYS Student Aid Programs: TAP



NYS Student Aid Programs: TAP

- Undergraduates
- Need-based, up to \$5,165/year
- Full-time and part-time study in NYS
- Based on NYS Income Tax information

Institutional Aid



- Depends on funding at each college
- College determines eligibility criteria for need based and non-need-based programs
- **Academic, athletic, and other talent-based scholarships and grants**
- May require an additional application
