BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this Agreement shall commence April 18, 2023, and terminate on August 31 2023; And the fee, not to exceed \$7,500 will be paid through the district's Employment Preparation Education (EPE) grant funds.

B.2.n. Contract for Long Island Science Center

B.2.q. Contract for Shepherd's Gate Academy
